If you would like us to arrange accommodation there is a 50 GBP non-returnable placement fee.

Homestay accommodation includes a single room, breakfast, and dinner each day (also lunch at the weekend), and basic laundry. Junior students also receive a packed lunch each school day. Executive homestay includes en-suite bathroom facilities. We ensure that no two students of the same mother tongue are staying with the same family unless requested.

Students should arrive with their Host Family on the Sunday before their course starts, and leave on the Saturday after their course finishes.
